

How does Juvederm work?

Juvederm is a range of hyaluronic acid facial filler and each smooth gel formulation addresses a specific and unique issue. The gel is injected under the skin by your surgeon. This fills lines and wrinkles and adds subtle volume.

The hyaluronic acid within the gel retains moisture. Depending on the treatment and product, results can last up to 12 months. Juvederm is also formulated with Lidocaine, an anaesthetic, which makes the treatment more comfortable.

Why Juvederm?

- Has a better lasting longevity
- Softer and easier to inject
- Can last between 9-12 months (though top ups may be required)
- Treatment is carried out by experienced surgeons, as they know the exact contour of the face and therefore the volume amount suited to your face.

How does Botox work?

Botox blocks signals from the nerves to the muscles. The injected muscle can no longer contract, which causes the wrinkles to relax and soften. It is most often used on forehead lines, crow's feet (lines around the eye) and frown lines.

Why Botox?

- Patients may see improvement within 2-3 days of injection
- Results can last up to 4 months
