

## What is Nose Correction Surgery?

Nose surgery, or rhinoplasty, is a cosmetic surgery procedure to reshape your nose. You may feel your nose is too big for your facial features, or you have an unattractive bump or sagging tip. You may have even had an accident or injury that's left your nose looking distorted and crooked. Whatever the reason, nose surgery can effectively change the appearance of your nose and help you feel more confident.

Everybody has different tastes and preferences, meaning Nose Correction Surgery can vary a bit depending on the final goal. The procedure is performed under general anaesthetic and most incisions are tiny and most are made inside the nose, so they will not be visible afterwards.

In most cases, bone and cartilage are removed or shaved down to either shrink the appearance of parts of the nose or to widen the breathing passages. In a few cases removed cartilage or bone from one area might be used to build up another area to fashion symmetry of the nose.

## Nose correction usually involves:

### *Reduction Rhinoplasty*

The nose is made smaller as cartilage and bone is removed or rearranged through cuts inside your nostrils.

### *Augmentation Rhinoplasty*

The bone is reshaped through cuts inside or outside of the nostrils and artificial implants or extra cartilage are used to build up the nose to your desired look.

### *Rhinotip*

The tip of the nose and nostrils are altered to your desired shape.
