Why Sunekos for Body?

The building blocks of healthy skin are Collagen and Elastin, but as we age, our bodies' production of these proteins slows, fine lines and wrinkles increase and skin loses its elasticity, becoming loose or saggy.

Boosting the production of Collagen and Elastin then, holds the key to restoring vibrancy and revitalising the skin. Incredibly, Sunekos have unlocked a way to dramatically increase the body's own production of these proteins through their patented intelligent injectables, thus dramatically slowing and even reversing the aging process.

Quick glance guide to Sunekos for Body

- Treats: Skin laxity in the décolleté, tummy, arms, thighs, hands, knees, elbows and most places showing signs of age
- Anaesthetic: Topical anaesthetic cream
- Duration: 15 minutes (depending on size of the area being treated)
- Hospital Stay: No
- Recovery: There is no downtime following the procedure

What does Sunekos do?

Sunekos tightens the skin, improving its appearance and reducing fine lines and wrinkles. It also improves the texture of the skin, making it look fresher and more youthful which in turn improves self-esteem and confidence.

What areas can Sunekos treat?

Sunekos can be used to smooth and tighten the skin across the whole body but is particularly effective at treating décolleté, tummy, arms, thighs, hands, knees and elbows.

How does Sunekos work?

Fibroblasts are the cells responsible for the production of the proteins collagen and elastin (the building blocks of healthy youthful skin), but as we age, these fibroblast cells slow their production of these proteins. Additionally, there is a significant drop off in the production of collagen and elastin in women that have gone through the menopause.

Sunekos is designed to target the fibroblasts, giving them the amino and hyaluronic acids that they need, to stimulate them into boosting their production of collagen and elastin again. As well as improving the functioning of the fibroblast cells, Sunekos also sets about improving the environment that the collagen and elastin are being released into, meaning that they last longer.

The key thing that makes Sunekos so special is that it produces collagen and elastin in the same ratio that the body needs it in, giving better and longer lasting results.

When can I expect to see results?

Sunekos acts in a physiological way, and it is common to see improvements after the first session.

How many treatments will I require?

A Sunekos treatment course typically consists of 3 to 4 treatments depending on the severity of the laxity. The initial treatment is to activate the collagen and elastin production process, the second treatment starts the rebuilding and remodeling of the skin and the third & fourth treatments are designed to make the process last. These treatments each take place 2 to 3 weeks apart due to the cumulative effect of each treatment. It is then advisable to have an additional treatment at the 6-month point.

We would expect to repeat the process again at 12 to 18-months for maximum benefit

What happens in a Sunekos Treatment?

The aesthetic doctor will map out the areas that are to be treated. Once mapped they will inject the Sunekos in the desired volumes. The whole treatment will take approximately 15 minutes depending on the size of the area to be treated.

How long will it take to see my results?

Most patients report seeing results by the time they come back for their second treatment with improvements being reported right up to their 6-month top-up treatment.

How does Sunekos compare to other aesthetic treatments?

Fat Transfer: This is used to revolumise the areas of the body that have become lax, creating a more youthful appearance, but they do nothing to improve the quality or texture of the skin

PDO Threads: Threads are used to tighten sagging skin on the stomach, buttocks, back, inner thighs and upper arms. As with the treatments above, they do not address the texture or quality of the skin.

Morpheus 8: This treatment does improve the texture and quality of the skin, however the downtime can prove prohibitive to some people. A Sunekos treatment takes 10 to 15 minutes to complete while a Morpheus 8 treatment can take up to an hour. During your consultation the aesthetic doctor can advise on the best options based on your specific age and skin quality.

CO2RE Laser Resurfacing: This treatment does improve the texture and quality of the skin, however, as with Morpheus 8, the downtime can prove prohibitive to some people. During your consultation the aesthetic doctor can advise on the best options based on your specific age and skin quality.

A: Sunekos is one of the more comfortable aesthetic treatments and is relatively painless

Q: What is the downtime?

A: There is no downtime after a treatment

Q: What are the potential complications?

A: There are few possible complications, but the worst you could expect is some mild bruising or swelling

Q: Is Sunekos a filler?

A: No, while Sunekos is injected into the skin in a similar way to dermal fillers, it is designed to improve the quality and texture of the skin while filler is injected to change the underlying shape or fill in depressions.

Q: How long does a Sunekos treatment take?

A: A Sunekos treatment can take between 10 and 15 minutes depending on the extent of the area being treated.

Q: How many treatments will I require?

Preparation for Sunekos

Careful preparation before Sunekos treatments can further reduce bruising and improve results. You should:

- Avoid alcohol a day before treatment.
- Avoid any herbal medication for one week before injections.
- Stop any blood-thinning treatments, including aspirin and ibuprofen, for one week before the procedure.
- Avoid any filler treatments when you have your period.
- If you have any questions, the staff at Bella Vou will always be on hand to answer your questions and offer support.

What happens during Sunekos Treatment?

The aesthetic doctor will map out the areas that are to be treated. Once mapped they will use the cannula method to apply the Sunekos to the required areas in the desired volumes. The cannula method dramatically reduces the risk of bruising. The whole treatment will take approximately 15 minutes depending on the size of the area to be treated.

Recovery from Dermal Fillers

After the procedure, most people can go home and get on with normal activities. However, the staff at Bella Vou are always on hand to offer you a drink or a snack and answer any questions.

There is minimal downtime following the procedure. You will be able to get on with your usual activities; however, mild redness, small lumps, and a little bruising are normal for a few days after treatment.

Applying cold packs and sleeping with your head raised on a couple of pillows can reduce swelling and bruising. The team will advise on follow-up care and offer support and guidance at any time.
