What is a Mini Tummy Tuck?

Mini Tummy Tuck surgery, also known as a partial abdominoplasty or skin-only abdominoplasty, is a cosmetic procedure that targets the lower abdomen. It is designed to remove excess loose skin and fatty tissue from the area between the navel (belly button) and the pubic area. This surgery is an ideal option for individuals with mild loose skin, and it is known for its quicker recovery compared to a full tummy tuck. The goal of a Mini Tummy Tuck is to achieve a smoother, firmer lower abdomen, resulting in improved body contour. How is a Mini Tummy Tuck Performed?

During a Mini Tummy Tuck, a small incision is made just above the pubic area, allowing the surgeon to access the lower abdomen. Unlike a full Tummy Tuck, the belly button isn't affected during this procedure, which means it remains in its natural position and there is no scar around the naval; the only visible scar is hidden below the knicker line and is much shorter than a traditional Tummy Tuck scar - similar to that of a Cesarean scar.

This procedure is less extensive than a full <u>tummy tuck</u>, so it typically takes less time and involves a quicker recovery. Since it focuses on the lower abdomen, it is an ideal option for individuals with mild loose skin in that area. The incision is strategically placed to minimise visible scarring. After the surgery, patients wear compression garments to support the healing process and achieve a smoother, firmer lower abdomen.

Why don't we use drains?

Traditionally, after a tummy tuck, surgeons use drains to collect the fluid that builds up between the layer of repaired muscle and the abdominal tissue. The drains empty into external collection chambers which patients monitor and empty many times over the course of several days. Over time, the skin and muscles come together and begin to heal, but until that point, the drains are important to prevent seroma (i.e. fluid accumulation under the skin).

Our Tummy Tuck doesn't require drainage as stitches are made between the abdominal wall and the belly to allow the fluid to escape, preventing it from collecting in the space between. Avoiding the use of drains also minimises the risk of infection, results in faster healing times and reduces discomfort after the procedure.

What is the Recovery for a Mini Tummy Tuck?

Recovery from a Mini Tummy Tuck is relatively quicker and less extensive compared to a full tummy tuck. The typical recovery period for a Mini Tummy Tuck is approximately six weeks. However, some individuals might experience a quicker return to normal activities, sometimes as early as two weeks. It's important to note that the pace of recovery can vary among patients. In the initial days post-surgery, patients may experience discomfort, swelling, and bruising in the treated area, managed with prescribed pain medication. Compression garments support healing and reduce swelling. Light activity is encouraged, while strenuous exercise is gradually reintroduced as advised by the surgeon. Most individuals can return to work within a week or two, depending on their job's physical demands. The incision scar will fade over several months, with final results taking time as swelling subsides, leaving a smoother, firmer lower abdomen and improved body contour.
