What is a Mummy Makeover?

A Mummy Makeover is a combination of cosmetic procedures to rejuvenate your body and restore your pre-pregnancy appearance.

What happens in a Mummy Makeover?

Tummy Tuck or abdominoplasty: A tummy tuck is an operation to tighten and reshape the abdominal area. The specialist surgeons remove any excess skin and fat and tighten the underlying muscles to create a flatter, smoother, and more toned tummy.

Breast augmentation: Breast enlargement is surgery in which implants are placed behind the breasts. They increase the size of the breasts, provide uplift, and restore firmness and symmetry.

Breast lift: Women whose breasts have good volume but have sagged since childbirth, may benefit from breast uplift surgery, without augmentation.

VASERlipo ™: Vaser Liposuction is an advanced body sculpting procedure. Excess fat is removed to reshape and contour the body.

BodyTite is an advanced procedure that simultaneously reduces fat and tightens skin, offering permanent results.

Renuvion skin tightening is often performed at the same time as **VASERlipo™**. The device uses plasma energy to tighten loose skin to create a toned, smooth appearance.

How long is the recovery following Mummy Makeover surgery?

Bella Vou understands that mums don't have time for repeated procedures and a lengthy recovery. Treatment plans are designed so that you can get back to your family and normal life as speedily as possible.

Your recovery will depend on the surgical procedures and your general health and wellbeing. Most wounds will take around two weeks to heal, but it takes around four to six weeks to reach full strength.

Meet your surgeon

You will be offered a further appointment to meet your consultant before proceeding to surgery. This will give you a chance to find out more about the procedures, your recovery, and to ask any questions you may have. Your surgeon will talk you through the operations and take time to address all your concerns.

Preparation for Mummy Makeover surgery

The staff at Bella Vou will advise you on any pre-operative preparations to reduce your risk of infection and help your recovery.

You may be asked to stop taking aspirin or anti-inflammatory medication, which can increase the risk of bleeding. It's important to stop smoking cigarettes and e-cigarettes, which can impede the healing process. You should continue to shower daily, as usual. You will be advised about the time to start fasting in preparation for your general anaesthetic.

On the day of your surgery, you'll be welcomed to Bella Vou, given a gown to wear and escorted to the state-of-the-art operating theatre.

What happens during Mummy Makeover surgery?

A Mummy Makeover is performed under general anaesthetic. The specific surgery will depend on the procedures you are undergoing.

Tummy Tuck or abdominoplasty: A tummy tuck is an operation to tighten and reshape the abdominal area. The specialist surgeons remove any excess skin and fat and tighten the underlying muscles to create a flatter, smoother, and more toned tummy.

Breast augmentation: The surgeon will make curved incisions under the breasts and place implants either behind or in front of the muscles of the chest wall. They act to lift the breasts, increase their size and restore firmness and symmetry.

VASER™ Liposculpture: Vaser is an advanced procedure to remove areas of fat and sculpt the body. Excess fat is liquified and sucked out to reshape and contour the body.

BodyTite uses radiofrequency to melt fat into liquid form, so that it can be aspirated from the body. The heat also simultaneously tightens the skin to eradicate lumps and bumps.

Renuvion skin tightening can be performed at the same time as VASERlipo™. The surgeon inserts a Renuvion probe under the skin. The device uses plasma energy to tighten loose skin to create a toned, smooth appearance.

Recovery from a Mummy Makeover

Your post-operative recovery will depend on the procedures you have had. You will need to stay in hospital for one or two nights, to monitor your recovery and maintain your comfort. It's important to be collected by a friend or family member who can escort you home and support you as you recuperate.

You will be given pain-relief and a supportive pressure garment to reduce pain, bleeding, and swelling from your tummy tuck.

In general, you should be up and walking the day after surgery. By the end of the first week, you should be able to walk around the house. It will take two to three weeks before you are comfortable enough to drive a car or return to work. From four to six weeks, you can reintroduce exercise, gradually increasing activity as you regain fitness, strength, and confidence. Full recovery from a Mummy Makeover procedure is about six weeks.

You should wear the pressure garments day and night during your recovery. These support the scar, reduce swelling and bruising, and help you stay comfortable. The staff at Bella Vou will carefully monitor your recovery. After one week, the nurse and wound care specialist will check your scar. At around six weeks, your surgeon will check your progress, and at six months, the nurse and wound care specialist will see you again to ensure that you remain healthy, well, and happy with your results. If you have any questions or concerns, the staff are on hand to offer support and guidance every step of the way.

FAQs

What is the aim of a Mummy Makeover?

As a mother, you sacrifice a lot for your children. You give your time to ensure that they have the love and attention that they need. You spend money to provide for their wellbeing. You celebrate their successes, and you are their support in their failures.

It doesn't end there, however. Many mothers also sacrifice the youthfulness of their bodies after pregnancy. Over time, they may gain weight, develop sagging skin, or lose fullness and firmness in their breasts.

A Mummy Makeover is a series of procedures, many of which can be conducted during the same surgical session, to restore youthfulness and vitality to your body.

Will I get scars from a Mummy Makeover?

All surgery leaves scars; however, post-pregnancy surgery results in very discreet scarring. Incisions are placed in positions where they are hidden by the natural creases and folds of the skin. For many women, the scars progressively fade to become barely noticeable. Generally, the scars are fine lines. If they heal too widely, it is possible to revise them at a later time to be a fine line.

The breast lift and reduction scars may be partly concealed under the breast, depending on the procedure performed. Its location under the breast neatly hides the breast augmentation scar.

The tummy tuck scar runs from hip bone to hip bone, but it is low on the abdomen, falling within the pubic hairline and underneath the underwear and swimsuit coverage area. Liposuction scars are tiny and tend to become invisible with time.

Is a Mummy Makeover right for me?

The best candidates for a Mummy Makeover procedure are women who have completed their families. This is because a tummy tuck involves the surgical tightening of the abdominal wall and the removal of abdominal skin. After a tummy tuck, these structures no longer have the same ability to stretch to accommodate a pregnancy.

However, you can still have breast surgery and VASER Liposculpture, even if another pregnancy is a possibility for you.
